RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF VEHICLES AND DECLARING CERTAIN VEHICLES AS SURPLUS FOR THE TRI COUNTY AUTO THEFT TASKFORCE

WHEREAS, the City of Joliet is a home rule unit of local government and Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 provides that except as limited by this Section, a home rule unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, Tri-County Auto Theft Taskforce is a multi-jurisdictional authority handling auto theft related crimes, insurance fraud, and public outreach; and

WHEREAS, Tri-County Auto Theft Taskforce is funded through grants between the Illinois Secretary of State Grant and City of Joliet; and

WHEREAS, Tri-County Auto Theft Taskforce intends to trade in three vehicles on three new vehicles.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOLIET AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The City Council finds that the property described herein is no longer necessary and useful to the City of Joliet/Tri County Auto Theft Taskforce.

SECTION 2: The City Council authorizes the following purchases and trade ins:

SECTION 3: The City Manager is directed to work with the Tri County Executive Director to trade in the above surplus vehicles on the purchase of a new vehicle(s). The remaining purchase price will be funded through the State of Illinois Motor Vehicle Theft Prevention Council grant to the City of Joliet for the Tri-County Auto Theft Taskforce.

SECTION 4: All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions conflicting with any of the provisions of this Resolution shall be, and the same, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: Be it further resolved that the passage of the Resolution be inscribed permanently in the records of the proceedings of the Joliet City Council.

SECTION 6: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and recording, according to law.
