**Resolution Authorizing CDBG Funding for
CDBG 2025-2026 Residential Snow Removal Program**

WHEREAS, the City of Joliet is a home rule unit of local government and Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 provides that except as limited by this Section, a home rule unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs.

WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) is authorized by the Housing and Community development Act of 1974, as amended, and is administered by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development;

WHEREAS, the use of CDBG funds, identified as #14.218 in the Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance, is governed by U.S. Federal regulations 24 CFR Part 570; and

WHEREAS, the City of Joliet is a recipient of CDBG funds received from HUD through its submission of its 2025 Annual Action Plan, as amended, which included the use of CDBG funds for Public Service activities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Joliet will act as a leading agency for providing public service activities; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Joliet find it in the best interest of the City of Joliet to allocate an amount up to \$44,000.00 in CDBG funds towards the Residential Snow Removal Program for eligible residents of City of Joliet; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOLIET, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Mayor and City Council hereby approve the execution of a CDBG program led by the City of Joliet - in an amount up to \$44,000.00 for the CDBG 2025-2026 Residential Snow Removal Program.

SECTION 2: The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute the agreement on behalf of the City of Joliet.

SECTION 3: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and recording according to law.
