It is not a question and answer period and staff, and the City Council does not generally respond to public comments. The City Clerk has a copy of the public speaking procedures; please note, speakers who engage in conduct injurious to the harmony of the Council shall be called to order by the Presiding Officer and may forfeit the opportunity to speak.

MAYOR AND COUNCIL COMMENTS:

Councilman Mudron spoke about his attendance at the swearing in ceremony for seven new police officers.

Councilman Moreno congratulated Brent Fraser, Fire Captain Michael Ballard, and Tony Lakota on their retirements. He also spoke about Council Memo 186-26 and reminded residents to slow down in construction areas.
