RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF WILL FOR THE PLACEMENT OF LICENSE PLATE READING CAMERAS LOCATED ON COUNTY HIGHWAYS

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council has determined that it is in the City's best interest to approve an intergovernmental agreement with the County of Will, attached hereto and incorporated herein, regarding the placement of license plate reading cameras in the rights-of-way of County highways.

WHEREAS, the City of Joliet is a Home Rule Municipality under and by virtue of the Constitution of the State of Illinois.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOLIET PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AND HOME RULE POWERS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Mayor and City Council hereby find that the recitals contained in the Preamble to this Resolution are true, correct and complete and hereby incorporate the Preamble by reference as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

SECTION 2: The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement, which is substantially the same as attached hereto and incorporated herein, with the County of Will, regarding the placement of license plate reading cameras in the rights-of-way of County highways. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take such action as may be necessary for the City to comply with the terms thereof.

SECTION 3: Each section and part thereof of this Resolution is deemed to be severable and should any section or part hereof be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such ruling shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portion(s) of this Resolution.

SECTION 4: All resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with the terms of this Resolution are hereby repealed and of no further force and effect to the extent of such conflict.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND APPROVAL IN THE MANNER PROVIDED BY LAW.
