**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE FINDINGS AND CONCURRING IN THE RECOMMENDATION
OF THE LIQUOR COMMISSIONER AND DIRECTING THE APPROVAL OF AN APPLICATION
FOR A CLASS O *FULL LICENSE* PERMIT FOR 1401 GATEWAY BOULEVARD**

WHEREAS, the City of JOLIET, Illinois (City) is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized to act on applications for liquor licenses within the City of Joliet; and

WHEREAS, the Liquor Commissioner of the City of Joliet has received an application for the Class O (Outside Beer Garden), Full License Permit for the premises located at 1401 Gateway Boulevard, Suite 110, Joliet, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Liquor Commissioner has convened a hearing thereon in the manner provided by law and ordinance and has made certain amended findings of fact and has submitted to the Council his recommendations thereon; and

WHEREAS, the City of Joliet is a home rule unit of local government.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOLIET, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AND HOME RULE AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The amended findings of the Liquor Commissioner attached thereto and incorporated herein are hereby adopted in total as the findings of the Mayor and City Council.

SECTION 2: The recommendation of the Liquor Commissioner to approve said application for the issuance of a Class O, Full License, Liquor Permit is hereby concurred in.

SECTION 3: The Liquor Commissioner is hereby authorized and directed to approve said application by written order. A copy of this Resolution and the Approval Order shall be served upon the applicant within ten (10) days of the effective date of this Resolution.

SECTION 4: This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval.

SECTION 5: All resolutions or parts of Resolutions conflicting with any of the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6: Be it further resolved that the passage of this Resolution be inscribed permanently in the records of the proceedings of the Joliet City Council.
