#### **BACKGROUND:**

The purchase of a new full size end loader for the Department of Public Utilities was included as part of the approved 2025 budget. The existing piece of equipment that is utilized for this purpose is nearing the end of its usable life and has proven to be slightly undersized. Fleet Services has a desire to continue with the standardization of equipment in order to recognize cost savings on replacement parts, spare tires, and maintenance. The purchase of a Caterpillar brand loader will continue this practice as the City currently owns several other Caterpillar loaders. There is currently a suitable unit available for immediate purchase from dealer stock.

The Public Service Committee will review this matter.

#### **CONCLUSION:**

#### SUBJECT:

Approval of Payment for the Cost Share Balance of the Design Agreement for the Construction of a Downtown Flood Control Levee to the Department of the Army in the Amount of \$105,000.00

#### **BACKGROUND:**

In October 2024, the City of Joliet passed a Resolution to enter into a Section 205 Design Agreement with the Department of the Army (US Army Corps of Engineers) for the design of a flood control levee to allow for the removal of floodplain designation from portions of downtown and residential areas south of downtown. As of the effective date of the Agreement, design costs are projected to be \$1,231,000.00 with the Army Corp of Engineers (ACOE) funding \$800,500.00 and City responsible for the remaining portion of \$430,500.00.

The Department of the Army has requested the City provide an initial payment, in the amount of \$105,000.00, towards the City's portion of the design costs.

The Public Service Committee will review this matter.

#### **CONCLUSION:**

The Department of the Army is requesting a portion of the required cash contribution in the amount of \$105,000.00 for the design of a flood control levee.

Section 2-438 of the City of Joliet Code of Ordinances states that purchases whose estimated cost is in excess of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) may be awarded without written specifications or bidding under certain circumstances. One (1) of these circumstances applies:

(f) Purchases when authorized by a concurring vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the Mayor and City Council.

Funding for this project was included as part of the approved 2025 Capital Improvement budget. Funds will be charged to the 2025 Capital Improvement Engineering / Infrastructure (Org 30090270, Object 557200, \$105,000.00).

#### RECOMMENDATION:

Based on the above, it is recommended that the Mayor and City Council approve the payment on behalf of the Department of the Army for the City's share of the Section 205 Design Agreement in the amount of \$105,000.00 for the Joliet Downtown Floodplain Levee/Floodwall project.

Reference Design Agreement (DA) dated April 3, 2025, between the Department of the Army (USACE) and the City of Joliet for the Joliet Levee project. The City of Joliet is the non-Federal sponsor for the project and will provide 35% of the project cost.

Currently, our analysis show that the City of Joliet owes \$105,000 based on the receipt of \$300,000 in federal funds. These funds will be used to design a levee system that will be constructed on properties primarily owned by U.S. Steel Corporation and the Forest Preserve District of Will County's Old Joliet Iron Works preserve. 





#### **BACKGROUND:**

On August 28, 2025, the Department of Public Works received a formal request for a drive thru facility for a proposed Dunkin' Restaurant to be located at 107 S. Briggs Street. The restaurant is proposed to be constructed on the site of a former multi-unit commercial building on the southwest corner of the intersection of Briggs Street and Washington Street as part of a newly reconstructed multi-tenant building. The City's Planning Division has reviewed the preliminary site plan and has no remaining outstanding items.

The Public Service Committee will review this matter.

#### **CONCLUSION:**

The applicant has submitted a site plan to the Department of Public Works showing the operation of the proposed drive thru. The applicant has provided signage and pavement markings for adequate traffic flow into the drive thru while maintaining sufficient drive thru storage capacity to meet the requirements of the Department of Public Works.

As required by the City of Joliet Code of Ordinances, the Department of Public Works has reviewed the drive thru facility site plan (see attachment). Access to the site will be available from a full access driveway on Briggs Street. The developer has received approval for this driveway from the Will County Division of Transportation who has jurisdiction of Briggs Street. Additionally, as part of this redevelopment, the existing alley through the site will be vacated, and a utility easement will be provided to allow access the existing utilities located in the vacated alley. The developer has received approval for the alley vacation from each private utility company currently located within the alley. Upon final investigation, the Department of Public Works has determined that there is sufficient vehicle storage capacity on the site and therefore recommends approval of the drive thru permit, subject to approval of the final engineering plans.

#### RECOMMENDATION:

Based on the above, it is recommended that the Mayor and City Council approve the Drive Thru Permit for a Dunkin' Restaurant at 107 S. Briggs Street.



**SUBJECT:** Report on Utilities' Maintenance Activities

The following maintenance activities have been conducted since last reported at the August 4, 2025, Public Service Meeting:

<u>Hydrant Repairs</u>: Ten hydrants have been repaired. There are currently 94 out of service hydrants (1.1% of 8351) and 97 hydrants that are operational but need repairs (1.1% of 8351).

Valve Repairs: Eight valves have been reset or repaired.

<u>Water Main Breaks</u>: Thirty water main breaks have been repaired. For 2025 there have been a total of 126 water main breaks. For the same period of time, we had 128 water main breaks in 2024, 126 in 2023, 168 in 2022, 161 in 2021, 127 in 2020, 198 in 2019, and 178 in 2018.

There were eight new contracted services. On August 20, upon request of the Water Foreman, due to potential for the excavation to be too deep for our crews, Camco completed a water main repair on Laraway Rd. On September 5, due the Foremen declining the work, Camco completed a water main repair at 508 N Chicago St. Camco completed three Sewer repairs – all three repairs were due to the depth of the excavation and the Sewer Department assisted with all three of these repairs. These sewer repairs occurred on August 21, September 11 & September 19. On August 2, due the Foremen declining the work, Airy's Construction completed a water main break at 1401 W Jefferson St. On August 21, due to location and difficulty of the repair, Len Cox finished a water main repair for the City Foreman on Campbell Street and the Water Department assisted with Vactor. This water main break was in the project area of Len Cox's water main project. On September 13, due the Foremen declining the work, Austin Tyler completed a water main repair at 452 N Chicago Street.
