**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A 2025 JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JOLIET AND WILL COUNTY**

**WHEREAS**, the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) program has been authorized by Congress for the purpose of prevention or reduction of crime and violence and to improve the fair administration of the justice system; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Joliet and the County of Will are partners of the FY2025 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) program and have been awarded a Joint Allocation of \$96,673; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Joliet and the County of Will have agreed to split the award equally in amounts of \$48,836.50, and the Mayor and City Council City Manager be authorized to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the County of Will; and

**WHEREAS**, the FY2025 Justice Assistance Grant Program Funds, in the amount of \$48,836.50, be allocated and used by the Joliet Police Department.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOLIET AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1:** The Interagency Agreement between the City of Joliet and the County of Will, which Agreement is attached hereto and made a part hereof, is approved.

**SECTION 2:** The City Manager is authorized to sign the Agreement on behalf of the City of Joliet.

**SECTION 3:** All Resolutions conflicting with any of the provisions of this Resolution shall be, and the same, are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 4:** Be it further resolved that the passage of this Resolution be inscribed permanently in the records of the proceedings of the Joliet City Council.

**SECTION 5:** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and recording according to law.
