ORDER

This matter comes on pursuant to the application of Rochelle Saenz, for the issuance of a Class C liquor license at 861 N. Larkin Avenue. Public hearing on the application has been held pursuant to lawful notice and the application has been considered by the Mayor and City Council in accordance with the Joliet Liquor Code. Based on the foregoing, the Commissioner hereby makes the following findings of fact:

- 1. Rochelle Saenz applied for the issuance of a Class C liquor license for the premises located at 861 N. Larkin Avenue; a public hearing was held on February 28, 2024.
- The applicant has applied for the issuance of a Class C liquor license. A Class
 C liquor license authorizes the sale of alcoholic beverage in its original package, not for consumption on the premises.
- 3. The proposed premise is located at 861 N. Larkin Avenue, Joliet, Illinois. This property consists of a brick structure which is currently a stand alone grocery store. To the west and north is a high density apartment complex, to the east is single family residential, to the south is business.
- 4. The proposed premise is zoned for business, however the surrounding area is a large residential neighborhood.
- 5. A review of police department calls for service at the proposed premise over the past year reveals 104.
- 6. The criteria used in determining whether the issuance of a new liquor license is in the best interest of the City include the following:

Section 4-13(c)(10): The zoning, general character of the surrounding neighborhood, and the projected impact of the premises upon the surrounding neighborhood and the city as a whole.

Section 4-13(c)(11): The law enforcement problems, if any, which would be created by the opening of the premises.

The proposed premise (861 N. Larkin Avenue) is next to a residential area. The issuance of a liquor license at this location, regardless of class, will likely have a negative impact on the surrounding neighborhood, as well as the city as a whole. The amount and types of calls for service at surrounding addresses indicates that there are already law enforcement problems in that area; adding a liquor license would exacerbate them. Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Commissioner hereby concludes that there exists just cause to deny the application for the issuance of a liquor license.

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

That the application of Rochelle Saenz for the premises located at 861 N. Larkin Avenue for the issuance of a Class C liquor license be denied.
