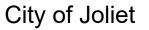

An advertisement for bids for the 2024 On-Call Excavation and Underground Utility Repair Program was published in the Labor Record on Thursday, March 14, 2024. The Public Service Committee will review this matter.

#### CONCLUSION:

On Tuesday, April 2, 2024, at 10:15 a.m., four (4) sealed bids were received in the Office of the City Clerk for the 2024 On-Call Excavation and Underground Utility Repair Program. The bid summary is as follows:

#### BACKGROUND:

The 2024 budget allocates funds for contracted restoration services in areas excavated by the Department of Public Utilities for water and sewer system repairs. Specific Contract work activities include repair and restoration of sidewalks, driveway aprons, street pavement, curb and gutter, and parkway turf grass. The Contract also includes a limited quantity of manhole / valve box frame adjustment. The Contract allows for a sixty (60) calendar day project duration for the initial list of work locations and a thirty (30) calendar day duration for subsequent lists throughout the year. Due to the duration requirements, the bid documents were prepared for on-call contractor services.

An advertisement for bids for the 2024 Utilities Restoration Program Contract was published in the Labor Record on Thursday, March 14, 2024. The Public Service Committee will review this matter.

#### CONCLUSION:

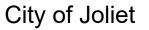

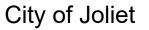

- Additional 8" gate valves and valve boxes
- Additional brick sidewalk removal and replacement
- Additional pavement markings
- Additional restoration of lawns and parkways
- Additional dust control
- Repair of uncharted water main
- Furnishing of reinforcing steel baskets for PCC pavement

Sufficient funds are available for this project in the Water Main Replacement Fund (Org 53880000, Object 557200, \$68,471.17).

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Based on the above, it is recommended that the Mayor and City Council approve Change Order No. 4 to the contract for the Plainfield Road (Black-Center) Water Main Improvements Project, in the amount of \$68,471.17, on behalf of Trine Construction Corp.

#### SUBJECT:

Change Order No. 1 for the Sidewalk Vault Improvements - 102 N. Chicago Street, 175 N. Chicago Street, 2 Clinton Street to Lindblad Construction in the amount of \$297,613.40

#### BACKGROUND:

In advance of the proposed 2024 Streetscape Improvements on Chicago Street, stabilization work will be completed on existing sidewalk vaults to ensure safe pedestrian access to businesses during mainline construction activities. The initial vault locations at 102 N. Chicago, 175 N. Chicago, and 2 Clinton Streets were awarded to Lindblad Construction on January 2, 2024, in the amount of \$1,855,941.00. The Public Service Committee will review this matter.

#### CONCLUSION:

Several issues that need to be addressed were identified during the sidewalk vault stabilization work currently underway. An undocumented sidewalk vault with a leaking water service was discovered at 173 N. Chicago Street. Additional vault stabilization work between Cass and Clinton Streets, sidewalk and stair repair at rear entrance of the Ottawa Street parking deck, and additional sidewalk to fill in the gaps between vault work are needed to maintain pedestrian access during the future roadway construction. It was also necessary to complete the replacement of the Rialto Theatre's water service and valve at night because a full water main shut down was required.

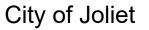
Change Order No. 1 is an addition in the amount of \$297,613.40. for the following items:

- 1) Addition of vault stabilization work at 173 N. Chicago.
- 2) Repair of water service at 173 N. Chicago.
- 3) Additional vaults and sidewalk between Cass and Clinton.
- 4) Addition of sidewalk and stair repair at the parking deck entrance.
- Replacement/repair of remaining sidewalk gaps to provide full pedestrian access during roadway construction.
- 6) Replacement of Rialto water service and valve during nighttime hours.

Sufficient funds exist utilizing the Capital Funds (Org 30090270, Object 557200, \$297,613.40).

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Based on the above, it is recommended that the Mayor and City Council approve Change Order No. 1 for the Sidewalk Vault Improvements - 102 N. Chicago, 175 N. Chicago, and 2 Clinton Streets, in the amount of \$297,613.40, on behalf of Lindblad Construction.

#### BACKGROUND:

The Illinois Department of Transportation is completing improvements to the I-80 corridor through Joliet. The bridge over the Des Plaines River will be replaced and relocated on an alignment to the north of the existing bridge as part of these improvements. The acquisition of additional right-of-way by IDOT is necessary to complete the bridge relocation. A city owned property has been identified by IDOT for purchase as part of this project.

663 S. Des Plaines Street is a small, non-buildable (3,615 square feet) City owned property. IDOT has submitted a fair market value property appraisal and has offered the City \$1,800.00 to purchase the property. The appraisal has been reviewed and found to be acceptable. A Resolution regarding the purchase of the property is attached.

In order to complete the sale of this property, it must be declared as surplus property. The City of Joliet's Purchasing Ordinance #7345, Section 2-435, provides in part that; "...when the City Council determined that any personal property with a remaining value is no longer necessary or useful to the City of Joliet," the property shall be declared surplus property by Resolution. A copy of this Resolution is attached.

The Public Service Committee will review this matter.

#### CONCLUSION:

It is in the best interest of the City to declare 663 S. Des Plaines Street as surplus property and sell the property to IDOT to allow the proposed improvements to I-80 to progress in a timely manner.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Based on the above, it is recommended that the attached Resolutions declaring 663 S. Des Plaines Street as surplus property and approving the sale of the property to IDOT be approved.

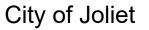
