SUBJECT:

Resolution Accepting Grant of Permanent and Temporary Easements for 126 Iowa Avenue on the Hickory Creek East Water Main Improvement Project

BACKGROUND:

On January 5, 2021, the Mayor and City Council approved Resolution 7613, committing to water conservation through the reduction of non-revenue water in order to comply with the allocation requirements of the Level of Lake Michigan Act, 615 ILCS 50, and the corresponding State regulations. A condition of the City's Lake Michigan water allocation permit is completion of the City's Non-Revenue Water Reduction Plan. A major component of this Plan is water main replacement. The Hickory Creek East Water Main Improvement Project is part of the 2024 Water Main Improvement Program. Permanent & temporary easements are required at 126 Iowa Avenue, Joliet, IL 60433 to build a portion of this project. The work is scheduled to be constructed in 2024. The Public Service Committee will review this matter.

CONCLUSION:

Staff has negotiated a permanent and temporary easement agreement with the owner of 126 lowa Avenue. The attached easement agreement will provide access for the Hickory Creek East Water Main Improvement Project. A total lump sum payment of \$1,500.00 has been agreed upon for these needed permanent and temporary easements:
